



S. No	List of Interviews	Key Discussion Summary Points
1	Undergraduate Students	I had an interaction with the under graduate students on October 26, 2015. The under graduate students were not aware about the project. I explained about the benefits of the TEQIP II project.
2	Post Graduate Students	Not applicable as there is no Post Graduate programme in the college.
3	Faculty	Interaction with the Faculty members was held on October 26, 2015. The faculty members expressed dissatisfaction for acute shortage of regular Faculty. They also informed that most of the equipment available are old, require repairs and servicing and some of them are obsolete.
4	Staff	I interacted with Non Teaching staff of the college on October 27, 2015. I along with Principal explained them about the project. They were also asked to identify the training requirement. The staff complained about the acute shortage of regular employees.
5	Senior Management	I had a discussion with Dr. Shashank Shekhar TEQIP co-ordinator on 25, 26 and 27 October, 2015 along with other senior Faculty members. The senior management also expressed difficulty faced by them due to very low strength of Faculty and Staff. However they said that teaching is continuing with the help of adhoc faculty members.

6	Members of the Governing Council	I interacted with the Chairman Board of Governors in the evening of October 27, 2015. He discussed about the problems faced by the college. He directed the Principal to prepare the agenda for Board of Governors meeting along with detailed agenda note. It is expected that Board of Governors meeting will be held within the month of November. I also met the Director Department of Science & Technology who is also a member of Board of Governors. He was very positive and optimistic. He expected that all hurdles coming in the way of smooth running of project would be over come soon and expressed the opinion that they will be able to implement the project properly.
7	Industry Representatives	I could not meet any industry representative during my visit.
8	Head of the Institution	I interacted with the Principal Prof. Nirmal Sharma on each and every day of my visit. He expressed difficulty in implementation of project due to acute shortage of Faculty and Non Teaching staff. Prof. Nirmal Sharma also accompanied me to the Director Department of Science and Technology as well as to the Chairman. After these meeting he also appeared more optimistic.
